晶彩科技身為企業的公民,基於企業社會責任與尊重國際人權,我們不支持也不使用所謂『衝突礦產』,並持續關注此一議題,同時發表不使用衝突礦產之聲明及詳實了解我們的供應鏈,確保钽 Tantalum (Ta)、錫 Tin (Sn)、金 Gold (Au)、鎢 Tungsten (W)、鈷(Co)、鈀(Pd)等這類金屬來源非由剛果民主共和國衝突區域之礦區開採,我們及我們的供應商伙伴並全力避免使用這些『衝突礦產』,以期改善礦產議題所帶來之衝擊。

Favite Conflict Minerals Policy

Conflict minerals are minerals mined in conditions of armed conflict and human rights abuses, notably in the Democratic Republic of the Congo, such as Tantalum (Ta), Tin (Sn), Gold (Au), Tungsten (W), by armed parties who are often affiliated with various armed rebel groups. The profits from the sale of these minerals finance continued fighting in Second Congo War, and control of lucrative mines becomes a focus of the fighting as well.

Favite, as the citizen of the world, supports human rights, and embraces its Corporate Social Responsibility. We will keep paying attention to this issue, and do due diligence to ensure that Favite and Favite's suppliers avoid using conflict minerals.
